THE VALUE OF SAC MEMBERSHIP

SEA is a 9-year-old aerospace & defense non-profit alliance founded by prime and tier-one companies and led by sub-tier suppliers committed to accelerating supply chain performance. SEA provides a voluntary certification that creates more visibility and new business opportunities for suppliers. SEA customers enjoy increasing performance, reduced risk, and best value.

This package includes a number of courses and webcasts designed to support a supplier's implementation of the SEA Roadmap. There is a step-by-step process to follow – a series of webcasts that are included in the Performing Membership, and training materials with a train-the-trainer course called the SEA Leader Workshop.

SEA Suppliers are accelerating their improvement effort. When they begin as "Members" they are educating themselves in best practices to SEA certification. Next they create an "Annual Improvement Plan" and participate in the "Quarterly Performance Review" process submitting quarterly reports for review by a SEA examiner who qualifies the supplier for the "Performing" status. Those suppliers who continue their efforts achieve SEA Certification. SEA Certified Suppliers are setting the performance bar for the Aerospace & Defense Industry..

SEA LEADER CERTIFICATION WORKSHOP – 24 hours, Participants: Unlimited – Irvine, CA.

In this in-depth, 3-day workshop, you'll gain an understanding of the SEA Lean Enterprise System (LES), the SEA Roadmap, and how to prepare your company for the SEA Certification.

0. GETTING STARTED WITH SEA – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast provides a step-by-step process for those who are implementing SEA internally using their own resources. This methodology is also included in the SEA Leader Workshop and is for senior leaders.

1. LES FOR MANAGERS WEBCAST – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

Create a "burning platform" with your entire management team – get everyone on the same page with the changes occurring in the industry. Designed to create a high sense of urgency to implement SEA.

2. ANNUAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast is focused on how to complete the Annual Improvement Plan. It is recommended for senior leaders who will prepare the company's goals, targets, and objectives.

3. ASSIGN PROCESS OWNERS – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast deals with the capabilities, roles, and responsibilities of the process owner. It asks senior leaders to assign process owners to each Roadmap process.

4. ROADMAP PROCESS OWNER – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast prepares the SEA Roadmap Process Owner for the tasks required to gain SEA Certification. Examples are shown for Process Maturity Level 1-3 and how to meet the requirements of each.

5. PROCESS OWNER FORUMS – 44 hours (1 hour per week for up to 44 weeks). Unlimited participants

The Process Owner Forums give members an opportunity to share best practices and compare notes on the challenges of implementation of the SEA Roadmap. Each webcast is one hour long and forums for specific processes meet online once per quarter. The Process Owner Forum Download Library contains all past presentations and documents on each process and is available to Basic, Performing, and SAC members.

6. HOW TO PREPARE QUARTERLY REPORTS WEBCAST – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

Learn to set-up the data collection required and how to pass the examination process for this important SEA process that leads to "Performing" status with significant visibility implications.

7. VALUE STREAM MAPPING – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast deals with how to select the right value streams and processes as "managed processes" – how to align value stream mapping to your goals and priorities, and how Value Stream Mapping can help you set priorities and schedule Kaizen events.

8. MANAGED PROCESS OWNER – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast focuses on the unique challenges of maturing a managed process. Process Owners for managed processes should attend.

9. MASTER TRAINER – 1-hour webcast - unlimited participants

This webcast deals with how to assign and initiate a supply chain integration initiative. The target audience is senior leaders and the director or vice president of supply chain management and/or purchasing.

This webcast deals with how to prepare for the SEA Benchmark Site Visit program. SEA has many customers who wish to schedule site visits. SEA also hosts "virtual site tours" for customers who cannot attend a site visit.

SEA Leader Workshop - The SEA Leader Workshop is a 3-day train-the-trainer workshop for general managers and practitioners who intend to implement the SEA Roadmap and management system.

Visibility and Keynote Process - SAC members receive a listing on the Supplier Registry, and inclusion in a number of activities designed to provide positive visibility. SAC members make a "Keynote" presentation at a Supplier CEO Conference once per year where SEA will videotape the presentation and distribute through SEA's media distribution channels including the SEA YouTube Channel and LinkedIN's Aerospace & Defense Supply Chain Group.

Hosted Site Visits - SAC member will arrange and conduct 1-2 site visits per year – SEA promotes at no additional cost.

SEA Certification – SAC members receive a 25% discount on the cost of an independent auditor providing the 2-3 day onsite audit using the SEA Roadmap.
